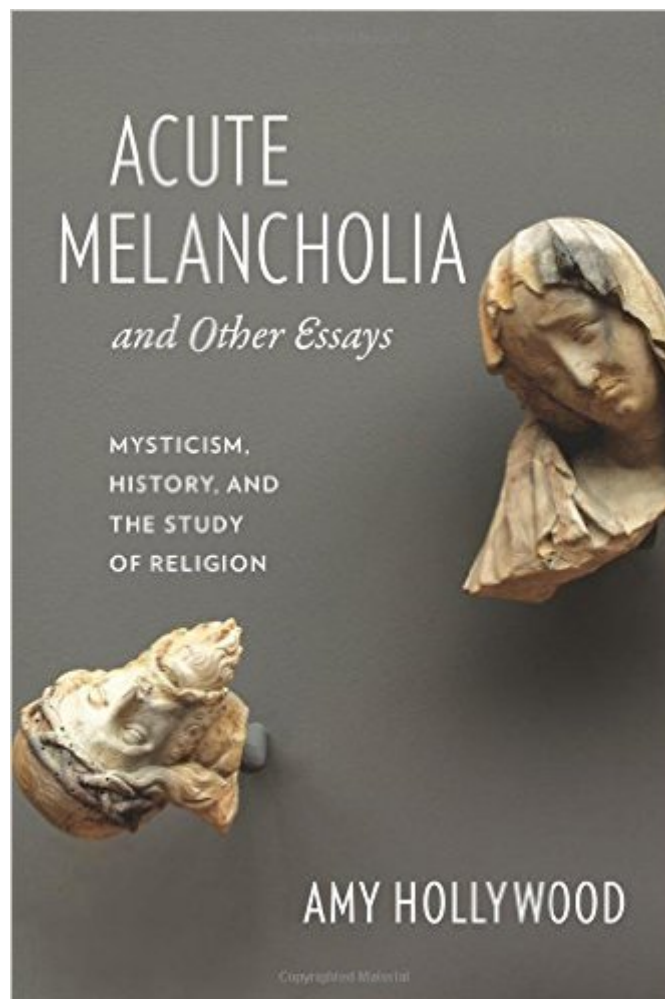


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Acute Melancholia And Other Essays: Mysticism, History, And The Study Of Religion (Gender, Theory, And Religion)
