

This pamphlet is specific to the Texas gulf coast, so it is very accurate if you fish in Galveston, Surfside, etc.

This is a good little guide to have in your tackle box. It doesn't have all of the fish you are likely to catch on the Texas Gulf Coast, but it has some pretty good pictures and descriptions of about 30 or so. I guess if they did all of the fish it would be so big it wouldn't fit nicely in the tackle box. Still a great guide and would make a great gift for anyone who fishes the Gulf Coast.
