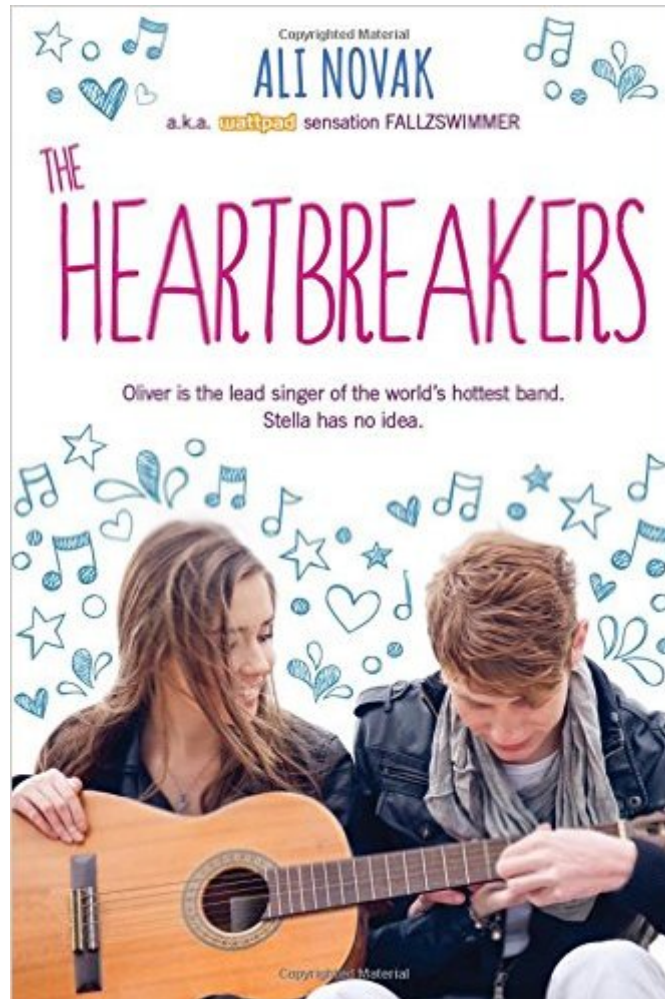

The Heartbreakers is a fun and entertaining read in spite of its emotionally laden plot.

A Quick Summary:
